Vice-Chairman Meyer called the meeting to order at 9:07A.M. CST in a meeting room.

Mr. Coffey made a motion to approve the September minutes with corrections, Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

DALE POWELL'S REPORT

Mr. Powell submitted his report to the Board. Mr. Coffey made a motion to approve the Inspector's report with corrections. Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

<u>Phelps Funeral Home</u>: Counsel Schell to write letter to Mr. Casebolt about someone besides himself having access to the embalming room when he is not available for inspections. Mr. Coffey made a motion for the letter to be sent, Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

<u>Hall & Jones Funeral Home</u>: Counsel Schell to write letter to Mr. Hall regarding the non-working eye wash station and shower that does not work and how this can be a violation for FTC or OSHA. Mr. Coffey made a motion for the letter to be sent, Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

<u>Stith Funeral Homes/Allison & Rose Funeral Home</u>: Patrick Hughes, Attorney for the Board, has made a motion for dismissal. Mr. Coffey made a motion to not agree to terms proposed by Mr. Gatlen, Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

<u>Letcher Funeral Home</u>: Chairman Percell spoke to the Ohio Board and was advised to submit a complaint against the funeral home in Ohio that is involved. Mr. Coffey made a motion to have Counsel Schell to file the complaint, Mr. Evans seconded; it carried 3-0.

Osborne Funeral Home (Evansville, IN): The Indiana State Board said they will put a hold on her 2018 renewal and she will have to ask to appeal before the Board to renew her Indiana State license.

<u>Cremation Society of Paducah</u>: The attorney for the establishment asked for an extension for turning in the response for the complaint.

<u>Evans Monuments and Cremation Services</u>: Tony Ratterman appeared before the Board to discuss the signage issued that caused a cease and desist to be issued last month. Mr. Ratterman has fixed the issue and the Board explained to him that the chapel has to stay setup at all times. The inspector will go to the establishment to issue the license back.
